PROCEEDINGS OF THE GOVERNMENT OF KARNATAKA

Sub: Grant of No Objection Certificate for establishment of Colleges of Education for the academic year 2004-2005.

PREAMBLE:-

1) The State Government have lifted the ban on issue of *No Objection Certificates* for establishment of B.Ed/B.P.Ed colleges in all mediums of instruction from the academic year 2003-2004 in G.O dated: 29-04-2003. In G.O. dated:02-06-2003, Mysore, Karnataka, Bangalore, Gulbarga, Mangalore and Kuvempu Universities were directed to advertise calling for applications for establishment of B.Ed/B.P.Ed colleges for the academic year 2003-2004 and to process the applications by following the procedures prescribed in section 59 of the Karnataka State Universities Act 2000 and thereafter to submit them to Government to enable it to consider for grant of NOCs under regulations 5 (e) of the NCTE Regulations 1995. It was clearly stipulated that while processing these applications, the norms and standards prescribed by the NCTE should be followed scrupulously.

2) Acting on this direction, the Universities have advertised calling for applications for establishment of B.Ed/B.P.Ed colleges and have processed the applications under section 59 of the KSU Act 2000. After completing the process, the Universities have submitted applications to the Government along with necessary documents.

3) Government have examined the recommendations received from the Universities keeping in view the number of existing BEd Colleges, their regional distribution/imbalance, the prolonged ban on establishment of teacher training institutions in the State, the demand for admission to BEd Course, the employment opportunities and also the future requirement of teachers in higher primary and higher secondary education sectors and various other factors incidental for taking a decision to grant *No Objection Certificates* for establishment of BEd Colleges in the State.

4) Hence the following order.



5) Government of Karnataka are pleased to grant issue *No-Objection Certificate* to Gokak Shikshana Samsthe, Gokak-591 307, Belgaum District for establishment of G.E. Society's College of Education, Gokak-591 307 Belgaum District for offering B.Ed course with an intake of 100 from the academic year

2004-2005 under Regulation 5(e) of the NCTE Regulations 1995, subject to the following conditions:-

- (1) No grant-in-aid shall be sought from Government for running the proposed college; it shall be subject to permanently unaided policy of the State Government. The institutions shall given an undertaking to Government to this effect at the time of sanctioning affiliation based on the recognition to be granted by the NCTE-SRC.
- (2) The institution shall provide adequate infrastructure, staff etc., as per the norms and standards, prescribed by the National Council for Teachers Education and also the affiliating University;
- (3) The institution shall abide by the orders/rules of the State Government and the statutes and regulations of the affiliating University issued from time to time with regard to admission policy and recruitment of staff to the institution etc;
- (4) The institution shall collect 'Tution fee' and 'Other fees' as prescribed by the State Government from time to time. The amount collected shall be utilized by the institution in accordance with rules;
- (5) The management should start the institution only after obtaining recognition from the National Council for Teacher Education under Section 14 of the NCTE Act, 1993.

ORDER

WHEREAS, the recognition was granted to the institution namely **Gokak Education Society's College of Education, Falls Road, Gokak, Belgaum District-591307, Karnataka** run by **Gokak Education Society, Gokak, Belgaum Dt. Karnataka** vide SRC (NCTE) order no. F.SRO/NCTE/B.Ed/2005-2006/4822 dt. 21.12.2005 for conducting B.Ed. course of one-year duration with an annual intake of 100 students.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, on promulgation of NCTE Regulations, 2014, the institution is submitted affidavit dt 30.01.2015 for its willingness for adherence of provisions of new Regulations. A revised provisional recognition order was issued to the institution on 16.05.2015 for conducting B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 (two basic units) from the academic session 2015-16.

3. **AND WHEREAS**, a letter was sent to the institution regarding V.T Inspection on 22.06.2016. As per the decision of SRC the inspection was conducted on 22.10.2016 and the V.T report received in this office on 24.10.2016.

4. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 381st meeting held on 31st Oct & 01st Nov, 2019 considered the matter and decided to issue SCN. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC a First show cause notice was issued to the institution on 06.11.2019. The institution vide letter dated 19.11.2019 submitted its reply to the First show cause notice.

5. **AND WHEREAS**, the SRC in its 383rd meeting held on 07th – 9th January 2020 considered the matter and decided to issue Final Show Cause Notice to the institution. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC Final Show Cause Notice was issued on 16.01.2020. The institutions vide letter dated 08.02.2020 submitted reply to the Final Show Cause Notice. The SRC in its 385th meeting held on 03rd March, 2020 considered the matter and decided as under:-

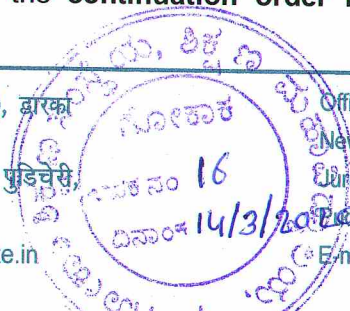

6. **NOW THEREFORE**, this order is issued permitting the institution i.e. **Gokak Education Society's College of Education Sy. No. 215/2, 221/1A/1/2, Near Basaveshwar Circle, Fals Road, Gokak, Belgaum District-591307, Karnataka** run by **Gokak Education Society, Gokak, Belguam Dt. Karnataka** for continuation of recognition for B.Ed course of two years duration with an intake of 100 students (**2 basic units**) of subject to fulfillment of the following conditions:

- I. The Endowment fund of Rs. 5 lakhs and Reserve fund of Rs. 7 lakhs kept in joint account with Regional Director of NCTE should be maintained perpetually. Raising loan against the FDRs or mortgaging them shall not be done.
- II. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time.
- III. The institution shall make admissions only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(10) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2014.
- IV. The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff duly approved by affiliating body for conducting the course should always remain in position.

7. Further, the institution is required to fulfill all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University /Body, the State Government etc as applicable.

8. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee as Self – Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.

9. The institution shall maintain its Website with hyperlink to the Council and the Southern Regional Committee, covering, inter – alia, the details of the institution, its locations, name of the programme(s) with intake; available of physical infrastructure, such as land, building, office, classrooms, and other facilities of amenities; instructional facilities, such as laboratory and laboratory and library and the particulars of their teaching faculty and non-teaching staff with photographs, for information of all concerned. The information with regard to the following shall also be made available on the website namely:-

- e. Fee charged from students;

- f. Available infrastructural facilities;
 - g. Facilities added during the last quarter;
 - h. Number of books in the library, journals subscribed to and additions, if any, in the last quarter;
 - i. The affidavit with enclosure submitted along with application.
 - j. The institution shall be free to post additional relevant information, if it so desires.
 - k. Any false or incomplete information on website shall render the institution liable for withdrawal of recognition.
10. The institution shall adhere to the mandatory disclosure in the prescribed format and display up-to-date information on its official website.

ORDER

WHEREAS, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section(2) of Section 32 of the National Council for Teacher Education Act, 1993(73 of 1993), and in supersession of the National Council for Teacher Education [Recognition Norms and Procedure] Regulations, 2009, the National Council for Teacher Education has notified the Regulations, 2014 on 1.12.2014.

2. AND WHEREAS, the institution **Gokak Education Society's College of Education, Falls Road, Gokak, Belgaum District – 591307, Karnataka** has by affidavit consented to come under New Regulations and sought for two basic units in B.Ed which require additional facilities.

3. AND WHEREAS, on scrutiny it is found that the institution has not maintained/revalidated the Fixed Deposited Receipts towards Endowment and Reserve Funds.

4. AND WHEREAS, it has been decided to permit the institution to have two basic units of 50 students each subject to the institution fulfilling following conditions namely,

- I. The institution shall submit revalidated FDRs of the enhanced values, in joint account with the SRC before 30 June, 2015 failing which the recognition will be withdrawn.
- II. The institution shall create additional facilities that include (a) additional built-up area, (b) additional infrastructure, (c) additional staff as per Regulations, 2014 and inform Regional Committees with required documents by October 31, 2015.
- III. The applicant-institution for additional unit will be required to submit the required documents such as land documents, Encumbrance Certificate (EC), Land Use Certificate (LUC), Building Plan (BP) and the Approved Staff List in the specified proforma available on the website to the Regional Committee in proof of having provided additional facilities before October 31, 2015. Building Completion Certificate (BCC) may be given along with other documents if available, otherwise it can also be given to the Visiting team at the time of inspection.

The Regional Committees shall arrange for verification of documents, inspection of these premises and check adherence to these conditions by 20 Feb, 2016. If it is found by the Regional Committee that the institution fails to comply with these requirements, the institutions shall not be permitted to admit students for the academic year 2016-2017.

5. NOW THEREFORE, in the light of the above and in terms of Section 14(3) of NCTE Act and in accordance with the Regulations, 2014, the Southern Regional Committee, NCTE hereby grants recognition to **Gokak Education Society's College of Education, Falls Road, Gokak, Belgaum District – 591307, Karnataka** for conducting B.Ed programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 for two basic units of 50 students each from the academic session **2015-16** subject to submission of revalidated FDRs of the enhanced value in joint account with the SRC before 30 June, 2015 and fulfilment of the conditions mentioned at II & III herein before 31.10.2015.



In terms of Section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 Gokak Education Society, Gokak, Belguam Dt., Karnataka had submitted an application to the Southern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition to Gokak Education Society's College of Education, Falls Road, Gokak, Belguam Dt. -591307. 2. On scrutiny of the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith and the input received from the visiting team, the Committee has noted the following:
 - a. The institution has acquired the land for setting up the teacher education institution.
 - b. The institution has constructed the building for conducting the course on the above mentioned land.
 - c. The institution has created an Endowment Fund of Rs.5 lakhs and a Reserve Fund of Rs. 3.2 lakhs.
 - d. The institution has selected the Principal and Seven lecturers for the said course and the list of faculty members has been approved by the affiliating University.
3. Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3)(a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Southern Regional Committee hereby grants recognition to Gokak Education Society's College of Education, Falls Road, Gokak, Belguam Dt. -591307. Karnataka for Secondary(B.Ed) course of one year duration from the academic session 2005-2006 with an annual intake of 100 students subject to fulfillment of the following.
 - a. The institution will ensure that Principal and Seven faculty members duly approved by affiliating University are in position for an intake of 100 students before commencement of the course and a report to this effect shall be sent to the Southern Regional Committee immediately and in any case not later than one month from the date of commencement of the course.

- b. The institution shall, within one month of the receipt of recognition order, convert the Endowment fund account into a joint account to be operated along with an official of the Southern Regional Committee.
 - c. The institution shall shift to its own premises / building within three years from the date of recognition. (in case the course is started in rented premises)
 - d. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE Regulations.
4. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like the affiliating University, UGC, State Government etc.
 5. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Performance Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with a copy of the approval of the affiliating University to the appointment of faculty members, and the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.
 6. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or any of the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued thereunder, the Regional Committee may withdraw the recognition under the Provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993.
